

1 Comprehensive Medication Review

2 Targeted Medication Review

Get the most from your medicines with a personal medicine review as part of your Medicare Part D plan. The two-part **Medication Therapy Management (MTM) program** reviews the medicines you take to make sure they're safe and effective.

Your review is at no cost to you. It's part of your Medicare Part D prescription drug plan.

THE MTM PROGRAM HELPS YOU:



BE SAFE

The review looks at all your medicines, as well as any supplements and vitamins you take.

Your review is private and will last about 30 minutes. During the review of your medicines, you can ask any questions you have.

- Learn about possible problems when taking many medicines.
- Identify over-the-counter products that may affect your medicines.
- Hear about treatment options that you and your doctor can discuss to help you get the best outcome from your medicines.

If your medicine review uncovers a serious issue, your pharmacist will alert your doctor right away.



FEEL GOOD

The review can help make sure your medicines work as well as possible.

The MTM program is right for you if you want answers to any of the questions below:

- Why am I taking these medicines?
- Do over-the-counter products work well with my prescriptions?
- Can I save money on my prescriptions?



SAVE MONEY

The review can help you save money on your medicines.

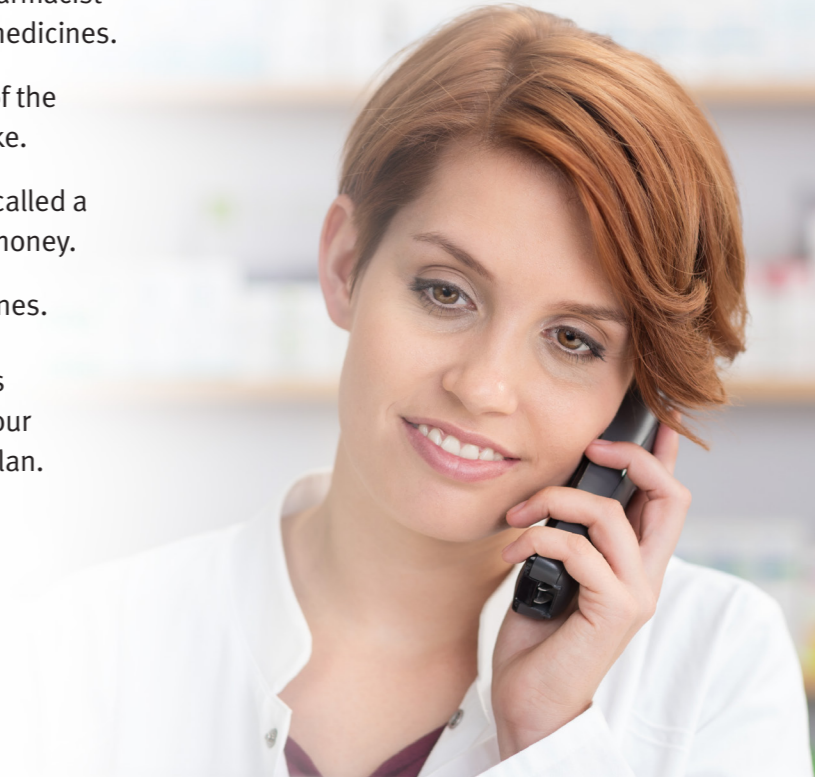
A medicine review may find that you can take fewer medicines. Your MTM pharmacist may be able to suggest lower cost medicines.

- See how your plan's drug list (called a formulary) can help you save money.
- Point out any duplicate medicines.
