Get the most from your medicine therapy with a personal medicine review from your Medicare Part D plan. The two-part **Medication Therapy Management (MTM) program** reviews the medicines you take to make sure they're safe, effective and fit your lifestyle.

Comprehensive medicine review

Talk one-on-one with a pharmacist. Learn more about your different medicines and how they work. Understand side effects, possible interactions and more.

After your review, you'll get a complete list of your medicines and an action plan that you can bring with you to your next doctor's visit.

Targeted medicine review

And, every few months, the program will review your prescription claims to make sure there are no issues that need attention. We may contact your doctor if we spot a potential problem with your medicines.

Your review is at no extra cost to you. It's part of your Medicare Part D prescription drug plan.

The MTM program helps you:

It looks at all of your medicines, as well as any supplements and vitamins you take.

Your review is private, and will last about 30 minutes. After your MTM pharmacist reviews your list, you can talk about any concerns you may have.

-  Learn about possible drug interactions
-  Identify over-the-counter products that may affect your medicines
-  Hear about treatment options that you and your doctor can discuss, to help you get the best outcome from your medicine

If your medicine review uncovers a serious issue, your pharmacist can even work with your doctor to help resolve it.

It can help make sure your medicine works as well as possible.

Too much medicine may cause you to feel worse. Too little medicine may not help you feel better. The MTM program can help you reach your health goals, and help you feel better.

-  Find out the best time of day to take your medicines
-  Learn how to deal with side effects, or avoid them altogether
-  Make sure your doses are within the best range for you

It can help your wallet stay healthy, too.

A medicine review may find that you can drop a medicine or change to a lower dose. Your pharmacist may even suggest lower cost options for medicines you currently take.

-  Learn about generic versions of many brand-name medicines you take
-  Understand how your plan's drug list (called a formulary) can help you save
-  Identify any duplicate medicines
